INTRODUCTION: In Philippians chapter 1, Paul's letter addressed to the Saints in Christ at Philippi along with the overseers and deacons starts on a note of prayer for the saints, that is, the church. He dedicates the next few verses to thankfulness and prayer to God. The letter then showcases the reality of how Christ is preached and that to live is Christ. The chapter closes with his striving and suffering for Christ.

1: THANKFULNESS AND PRAYER TO GOD: Verses 1 – 11:

 ALWAYS BEGIN WITH THANKSGIVING – Philippians 1:3; Psalm 100:4; 1Thessalonians 5:18; Philippians 4:6.

Paul starts by praying for grace and peace from God to the church.

- SPIRITUAL JOY/ SAINTS FELLOWSHIP Philippians 1: 4 5; Nehemiah 8:10.
 Paul prayed joyfully for the church for their partnership.
- BROTHERLY LOVE LEADING TO SPIRITUAL DISCERNMENT Philippians 1: 9 11.

2. CHRIST IS PREACHED – Philippians 1: 12-18

- REJOICE IN PREACHING THE GOSPEL Philippians 1: 12; 2 Timothy 2:3;2 Timothy 4:2; 2 Timothy 3:12.
- SPEAK THE WORD FEARLESSLY Philippians 1: 14; 2 TIMOTHY 4:2; 1Corinthians 11:1.
- DONT BE DISCOURAGED BY FALSE PREACHERS: Philippians 1: 15, 17.
- IRRESPECTIVE OF MOTIVE, REJOICE WHEN CHRIST IS PREACHED: Philippians 1: 18.

3. TO LIVE IS CHRIST - Philippians 1: 19 - 26

- PRAYERS AND THE HOLY SPIRIT ARE NEEDFUL Philippians 1: 19; James 5:16.
- READINESS FOR LIFE OR DEATH: Philippians 1: 20-21.

4. STRIVING AND SUFFERING FOR CHRIST- Philippians 1: 27 – 30

- GOOD CONDUCT IS PRESCRIBED Philippians 1: 27; Ephesians 2:10
- UNITY OF FAITH Philippians 1:27; Ephesians 4:13; Acts 4:32.
- FEAR NOT- Philippians 1: 28; Isaiah 41:10; 2 Timothy 1: 7; Proverbs 29:25.
- BE READY TO SUFFER FOR CHRIST Philippians 1: 29; Matthew 10:22, 39; Acts 9:16; John 16:33; Philippians 3:10; Daniel 3: 16 18
