TOPIC: GETTING TO KNOW GOD

INTRODUCTION: Understanding who God is and developing a relationship with Him is one of the most important aspects of our spiritual walk and growth. This process involves actively seeking, trusting, and communicating with God, which is helpful and essential for nurturing our Faith. It safeguards us from being misled and manipulated by false teachers, practicing false doctrines and believing wrong interpretations of the gospel, **2 Peter 2:1-3. *You may hear about God from others but truly knowing Him is a personal experience.***

Outline 1: The importance of seeking God and knowing Him personally (Jeremiah 29:13, Hosea 6:3, John 5:39, 2 Tim 2:15, Josh 1:8, Luke 10:38-41, Mark 1:35, Eph 3:17-17)

To seek means to search, look for, hunt, inquire, probe, chase, find, go after, it emphasizes the level of commitment and determination to know God. God is assuring us that if we put in the effort of searching for Him, we will find Him, even though he is not missing, neither did he leave his throne, we are the ones who are far from him due to our unbelief in his word and promises.

It is important to seek God personally and intentionally, if we do not want to become victims of manipulators of the gospel. It is also crucial for personal development and growth in our walk, as it helps us to stand firm in our belief in God

The word of God assures that a sincere pursuit of God is a win-win for us if we genuinely search for Him.

Outline 2: Building faith and trust in God (Hebrews 11:6, Romans 10:17, Luke 5:5-6, Matt 8:5-13, Jude 1:3,20)

Faith is the foundation and bedrock of knowing God. Knowing, believing, accepting and trusting Christ. Trusting the scriptures ensures the success of our walk with Him and guarantee access to his supernatural supplies.

Whenever there is no manifestation of faith, divine intervention is suspended, delayed and denied. Never entertain thoughts that will erode faith and replace it with doubt and fear. God is too faithful to fail

Outline 3: Prayer and Communication: Communicating with God through prayer (Psalm 145:18, 1 Thessalonians 5:17, Mark 1:35, Matt. 21:22, Phil 4:6, Col. 4:2)

Prayer is the oil that keeps our faith, trust and confidence in God active and productive. Through prayers, we nurture our connection with God, never stop praying no matter the situation life may bring your way.

The challenges of life cannot be overcome by mere wish but by prayer, so keep praying.
