Why Vision 2032 Matters to Every Member

1. Aligns with the Great Commission

God's pattern is always increase. Vision 2032 pushes RCCG beyond maintenance — towards numerical growth, parish expansion, leadership multiplication and greater excellence in ministry.

5. Builds Generational Continuity

A church that does not prepare the next generation eventually declines. Vision 2032 prioritises youth empowerment, mentorship and raising future leaders to sustain revival.
