DIGGING DEEP: AUGUST 18, 2026

THEME: OUR MONTH OF NEWNESS

TOPIC: MOUNTAIN MOVERS

TEXT: Mark 11:23

INTRODUCTION:

The Redeemed Christian Church of God [RCCG] recently concluded its 74TH Annual Convention with the theme “Mountain Movers”. Tonight, we dig deeper at some of the issues discussed at the Convention. Ordinarily, someone would ask what is a mountain? A mountain in this way can be described as any big obstacle such as sickness, an object of fear, debt, stagnation, etc. We have instances in the Bible that typifies mountains that were moved. For example: The Red Sea in Exodus 14; David and Goliath in 1 Samuel 17, the case of Lazarus and the grave in John 11.

In line with our text [Mark 11:23], God wants us to be mountain movers, indeed. May the Lord strengthen our faith to believe without doubt in Jesus’ name, Amen

OUTLINE A: IDENTIFYING THE MOUNTAINS

It is very important to know what we are dealing with. What is that problem that we want to move away?

1. Mountains are real obstacles. Some you may see or feel it; others maybe be spiritual. In Numbers 13:31-33; the 10 spies among the 12 spies saw a problem. They identified a mountain.
2. No matter how big or small we consider a mountain to be; God is certainly aware of that mountain. Psalm 139:2[NIV], Isaiah 46:10[NIV].
3. We must be specific and direct in our prayers to move that mountain. Mark 10:51.

Question: Is there a specific mountain that you want to move?

OUTLINE B: THERE ARE CONDITIONS FOR MOVING MOUNTAINS

God has given us the ‘tools’ that we need to move those mountains. Let us consider the following:

1. Faith without doubt. Hebrews 11:1 defines faith. Then we have, James 1:6-8, Joshua 10:12-14 [faith in action].
2. Prayer and fasting. Mark 9:14-29.
3. Speak the Word. Proverbs 18:21. You need to understand what to say, by taking God’s Word back to Him. 2 Timothy 2:15.
4. The Holy Spirit. Zechariah 4:6-7, Amos 3:3. A very important question: have you accepted Jesus as your Lord? You need to have that relationship with Him.

OUTLINE C: GOD IS THE ONE THAT MOVES THOSE MOUNTAINS

1. God moves the mountains through us and for us. Job 9:5[NIV], Isaiah 40:4. Joshua 6:1-20 is a classical case.

DISCUSSION: What is the major difference between the 10 and 2 spies sent by Moses to the Promised Land?

CONCLUSION

Mountain movers are not people without problems/challenges. Mountains do not move because you complained. Rather, they move by **FAITH+WORD OF GOD+PRAYER/FASTING+HOLY SPIRIT**. 1 Corinthians 2:4-5.
