GOD CAN CHANGE OUR POSITION

- God can move a person from grass to grace—and from grace to grass.
- Nebuchadnezzar moved from royal greatness to eating grass like an animal because of pride.
- Grace to grass can also describe falling from a high level of anointing or favour to the lowest point.
- Key references: Daniel 4:28–37; James 4:6; Proverbs 16:18; 1 Samuel 2:7–9.

THE RIGHT POSITION

A gracious believer is one who:

- walks humbly before God
- recognises that every elevation comes from God
- remains dependent on God even at the highest level
